Dear TEAM,

We've had a busy year at TEA Fund. We started 2021 preparing for the Texas Legislature—which is always a battle for reproductive rights, health, and justice organizations. We went into session ready to fight hard to see the passage of our Rosie's Law bill and ended it combating the most harmful anti-abortion law in our country.



On September 1st, Senate Bill 8 went into effect, causing 85% of Texans to leave the state to access abortion care. While SB8 has created many challenges, we have also seen an outpouring of love and solidarity from people across the country supporting our work and sibling funds in Texas. People are outraged and believe that Texans should have access to abortion care no matter how much money they have or where they live.

This year has been fraught with challenges but I am proud of our TEAM at TEA Fund. Our board, staff, volunteers, donors and supporters have made sure that we are showing up for our community by providing more funding than ever, texting hundreds of people about abortion care resources, providing education about abortion access, uplifting the stories of people who have had abortions, shifting the narrative, reducing stigma, fighting unjust anti-abortion laws, and creating healing spaces during this uncertain time. We have shown up for the people we serve and we have shown up for each other.

We appreciate your support and are so grateful that you choose to donate to Texas Equal Access Fund. It is because of your donations that we have been able to support Texans seeking care with more money. **We are challenging our donors to help TEA Fund raise an additional \$50,000 before the end of the year so that we can ensure that we can continue to fund callers at the level we are funding them during this time of extreme uncertainty.**
